### CBS

- Overall CBS had a good month.
- 23 sites.
- Fall sites going well.
- Addition to 1 ½ new coaches who just started. Would like at least one more part timer.
- New site RiverStar, starting next Friday

### Production

- PCC/Meyn- We received 4,800 meters of orders earlier this month. Last week we received another 600 meters in orders.
- Wincraft- We have been getting a lot of daily clocks as well as inventory builds. We have around 100,000 press buttons left to complete.
- Watkins- We have 32 different P.O.'s as of now. We currently have 3-4 orders that we have the product for in house to work on.
- Brian's toys- We just received in 4 skids of product from Brian's toys. That we need to bubble wrap/package
- WS Packaging- We have about 7 skids of product to run through our tunnels. File folders.

### Laundry

 On September 1<sup>st</sup> we started linen service for Saint Anne. To date things are going guite well considering the short startup time. Last week we had a follow up meeting with them on the first few weeks of service. They had a few concerns regarding wrinkles in table linen and chef coats which we have already started working on (we'll have to see what the results are). We had a few issues with the delivery process which they were willing to work with us on (extra linen handling for our driver). Within the plant the work for Saint Anne is really going well. Much of their work is easy hand folding, so we have added a coach and 6 DTH clients for a ½ day each

- day of the week to help with the added volume. We have been able to keep them busy along with filling in some previous work gaps throughout the day with existing workers. It looks like the volume from Saint Anne's will be about 75,000-85,000 pounds annually.
- We met with Good Shepherd (Rushford) on Wednesday about linen service. They are struggling hiring staff for laundry so they would like us to fill in the gap. We are going to start service for them September 30. We will only be processing bath towels, hand towels, wash cloths, fitted sheets, and flat sheets delivering on Tuesday's and Friday's only. We estimate the total volume of linens for Good Shepherd to be about 80,000 pounds annually. We will only processing a portion of those linens so 20,000-30,000 pounds is a good estimate of the volume we will be taking on.
- With the two new jobs we will be pushing 80% capacity. Adding business beyond this point is unrealistic without adding equipment. Both Saint Anne and Good Shepherd have additional volume that we could obtain in the future. Unfortunately the most likely way I see us obtaining this work is when equipment fails or employees leave and cannot be replaced. In both cases the laundry services needed will have a short lead time in taking on this new business. To meet that potential need I do think we should explore the potential of purchasing the 4<sup>th</sup> 200 pound washer and 3<sup>rd</sup> folder. Delivery on most equipment (used or new) is at least 3 months out. Plan fully adding these pieces of equipment would give us the needed capacity to respond quickly when the opportunity arises to add this volume.
- Existing work is going well with all laundry customers
